

From the Deacon

It is amazing how the human ear can recognize specific voices. Some say babies in the womb can recognize their mother's voice whether she be speaking or singing a lullaby. There are some voices we know right away just from hearing the first words uttered by someone familiar to us. We can recognize a person on the phone just by their hello. Jesus says "I am the good shepherd, and I know mine and mine know me...I have other sheep that do not belong to this fold. These also I must lead, and they will hear my voice, and there will be one flock, one shepherd." Do we recognize the voice of Jesus?

This Sunday's gospel presents us with the familiar image of Jesus as the good shepherd. The image of the good shepherd depicts Jesus in a very compassionate and loving pose gently caressing a single lamb close to his chest. It is a comforting picture that we can easily relate to. Each of us are represented by that lone lamb that is cradled in the arms of Jesus. But there is much more to this than just a loving pose of Jesus with the recovered lost lamb.

Jesus as the good shepherd wants more than just to nourish and feed us with his consoling love. As the shepherd whose only desire is to care for his sheep, he also wants to share the essence of his life with us to the point of giving all he has on our behalf. His mission is not simply to care for his sheep but to make them like himself by bringing them into his relationship with the Father.

In our second reading this weekend, the First Letter of John invites us to reflect on our relationship with God as we "see what love the Father has bestowed on us." We need to take the time each day to cherish those moments when we have felt God's presence in our lives. As we do this, we become more aware of how we are truly loved and that there can be nothing that will separate us from the love of the Father for us His children.

We follow Christ the Good Shepherd because he will always be there to gently keep us on the path to the Father. He is our certainty in a world that is oftentimes hostile to us. As Jesus relates to His Father in heaven, he invites us to the same intimate closeness with God. We can rest secured mindful that we are God's beloved children. Our future is secure and our hope eternal.

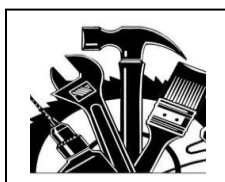

FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

Del Diácono

Es sorprendente cómo el oído humano puede reconocer específicas voces. Algunos dicen que los bebés en el útero pueden reconocer la voz de su madre ya sea que esté hablando o cantando una canción de cuna. Hay algunas voces que conocemos de inmediato solo al escuchar las primeras palabras pronunciadas por alguien familiar. Podemos reconocer a una persona por teléfono simplemente por su saludo. Jesús dice "Yo soy el buen pastor, yo conozco a mis ovejas ellas me conocen a mí ... Tengo otras ovejas que no pertenecen a este redil. Estos también debo guiarlos, y ellos oirán mi voz, y habrá un solo rebaño, un solo pastor." ¿Reconocemos la voz de Jesús?

El evangelio de este domingo nos presenta la imagen familiar de Jesús como el buen pastor. La imagen del buen pastor representa a Jesús en una actitud muy compasiva y amorosa acariciando suavemente un cordero cerca de su pecho. Es una imagen reconfortante con la que nos podemos relacionar fácilmente. Cada uno de nosotros representa ese cordero solitario que está sostenido en los brazos de Jesús. Pero hay mucho más en esto que solo una actitud amorosa de Jesús con el cordero perdido ya recuperado.

Jesús como el buen pastor quiere algo más que alimentarnos y nutrirnos con su amor consolador. Como el pastor cuyo único deseo es cuidar de sus ovejas, también quiere compartir la esencia de su vida con nosotros hasta el punto de dar todo lo que tiene en nuestro nombre. Su misión no es simplemente cuidar de sus ovejas, sino hacerlas como Él mismo. Hace esto, llevándolos a una relación con el Padre.

En nuestra segunda lectura de este fin de semana, la Primera Carta de Juan nos invita a reflexionar sobre nuestra relación con Dios cuando "vemos qué amor nos ha otorgado el Padre". Necesitamos tomarnos tiempo cada día para apreciar esos momentos cuando hemos sentido la presencia de Dios en nuestras vidas. Al hacer esto, nos volvemos más conscientes de cómo somos verdaderamente amados y de que no hay nada que nos separe del amor del Padre por nosotros Sus hijos.

Seguimos a Cristo el Buen Pastor porque Él siempre estará allí para guiarnos gentilmente en el camino hacia el Padre. Él es nuestra certeza en un mundo que a menudo nos es hostil. Cuando Jesús se relaciona con Su Padre en el cielo, nos invita a la misma cercanía íntima con Dios. Podemos descansar seguros de que somos los hijos amados de Dios. Nuestro futuro es seguro y nuestra esperanza eterna.
