People in the time of Jesus continued to be attracted to him and his teaching. They were so eager to hear from him that they pushed into the house where Jesus and the disciples stayed and wouldn't even allow them time to eat. They desperately wanted to share in the food of Jesus and his disciples. The food I mention here is the experience of the kingdom, its preaching, teaching and its deeds of power.

While many were attracted to Jesus, there were others who saw him as deranged and offensive. The family of Jesus was not prepared for his message and decided that they would have an intervention and take him away before he could cause any harm to the established way of thinking. Jesus had angered the religious leaders of Jerusalem and they accused him of working in cohort with the devil.

However, Jesus wouldn't have any of it and confronts his family and the religious leaders. Satan is a powerful adversary. He binds people in sin and refuses to let go. Jesus comes with a message of liberation and freedom from the grips of the devil. He is able to do this because his strength comes from the Holy Spirit. Jesus is able to plunder the house of Satan because he proves himself stronger than the devil.

When Jesus looks about the room at all those who have gathered around him, he asks: "Who are my mother and my brothers?" He responds by answering his own question with his eyes. Looking at all who are gathered, he proclaims that "Here are my mother and my brothers. For whoever does the will of God is my brother and sister and mother."

Jesus' family is no longer limited to blood relatives but rather to everyone that hears his word and lives it to the full. This is the wonderful message for this Sunday. We are invited to sit with Jesus and ponder his words of freedom in our hearts. We no longer have to be bound by old ways of sin and hardness of heart.

Jesus wants us to be his extended family. These are wonderful words indeed and they give us hope when sometimes our lives seem void of meaning. Mary was the perfect example of what it meant to ponder the word of God in her heart. May we follow her example and find freedom for our spirits in the process.
